Position Timeline:

- October – Be available to take photos at various fundraisers

- January – Be available to take photos at various events leading up to Winter Carnival
- Winter Carnival – Be available where needed to take photos of events
- After Winter Carnival – Upload photos in timely fashion

Time Commitment: Must be willing to commit 1-2 hours per month October – January and 10 hours during Winter Carnival.
